## 23rd Annual LoveWay Ride-A-Thon

23rd Annual LoveWay RIDE-A-THON in 2017 was held on their grounds in Middlebury, Indiana on Saturday, October 14, 2017. It was a 10 mile fundraising Trail Ride to benefit the activities at LoveWay. The Bristol Indiana Police and Bristol Marshal's Posse assisted at the event. It had been raining in the early morning, but it cleared up for the start of the race, although showers came and went during the day. This may have affected the number of riders who came out to participate. The day began with a pancake and sausage breakfast at 7am, which riders took as the opportunity to get a good meal before their ride. Bonneyville Carriage rides offered a chance for those without a horse to ride the trail. While the riders were out on the Trail, beginning at 10am, a Fall Frolic, open to the public, was held with many activities for children, and a bake sale for hungry attendees. All money raised from the event goes directly toward keeping LoveWay running. LoveWay is a not for profit Therapeutic Equestrian Service which has offered therapeutic horseback riding for children and adults with special needs since 1973, making it one of the oldest centers in the United States.
