Town Meeting Complex Review 3-22-18

A group of interested citizens joined Bristol Town Council Members, Bristol Police Department Officers, and officials from Jones Petrie Rafinski (J.P.R.) Engineering firm for the second public meeting to review the plans for the proposed Community Complex addition to the existing Town Hall/Police Department in Bristol, Indiana. The meeting was held at the Bristol United Methodist Church at 7pm on Thursday, March 22, 2018. Town Council team leader for the project and Town Council member, Jeff Beachy, led the discussion with both an electronic presentation and actual posters of the plans. The project is estimated to cost about 3.1 million dollars to be paid for by existing town funds and one of several other funding plans. Three local banks have expressed interest in providing a loan to the Town for the project, which is expected to meet the needs of a much-crowded police station and an currently non-ADA compliant building. The existing building was built in 1914, and would be retained as the new structure will be added to it and provide a new entrance on Apollo Street. Public comments at the meeting were positive as to recognizing the need for the new Complex to meet present and future civic needs.
