Jack Brainard was band director at the High School for many years, prior to its closing in 1966.

Peggy Leister-King, Class of 1949, June Vanantwerp-Applegate, Class of 1940, and Mary Jane Fisher, Class of 1940 were among the many other attendees.

Rex Gleim, a former teacher, spoke to the crowd on the fund raising efforts to preserve the old school building and asked for contributions. The original school was built in 1903 to consolidate and house eight one-room schoolhouses in a single building, with additions over the years.

It was known over the years at the Washington Twp. School, Bristol School & Bristol Hlgh School.

The last class graduated in 1966 and the school was closed, and pupils went to Elkhart High School.
