



Bristol's Starry Night Quilt Mural

For the first time, Bristol will have a Quilt Mural. The Bristol on the River (BOTR) Group is sponsoring the quilt mural "Starry Night" on the side of the Open Door Center at the corner of SR 120 West and SR 15 South at the center of Bristol using a 2019 design offered by the Elkhart County Convention and Visitors' Bureau who sponsor the Quilt Gardens and Murals along the Heritage Trail. The Mural was installed in time for the celebration that runs from May 30 to Sept. 15, 2019. The BOTR group raised the funds to participate in the event. President Cathleen Beachy and Member Whitney Pierle headed up the committee, assisted by the group. They held a "Meet the Mural" event for the public in Memorial Park across the street from the Mural on Sat. June 1 at noon. Member Linda Powell planned the colors of the town flowers to match those in in the quilt. There is also a Quilt Garden at the Elkhart Co. Historical Museum. The next BOTR meeting is May 3 at 6pm at the Library. Public Welcome.
