The Town of Bristol, Indiana is in Elkhart County, Washington Twp., few miles south of the Indiana and Michigan border. Population in the 2010 census was 1,602.

The Town Council consists of 5 members elected to staggered four year terms and meets the 3rd Thursday of each month at 7pm at the Town Hall, held the Tuesday before the Thursday meeting date. Both sessions are open to the public. Current Council members are from bottom left: Floyd Lynch, President and Cathy Burke. From left, back: Delbert Schrock, Ron Norman and Jeff Beachy. The other elected official is Town Clerk, Mary Ryman, who serves a 4 year term. Town Manager, hired by the Town Council is Bill Wuthrich. The Bristol Police Department consists of a Town Marshal, Michael Swallow and both full time and reserve officers and is located in the same building as the Town Hall. There is a volunteer Marshal's Posse.
